POLLS OPEN: 7:00AM TO 8:00PM

IMPORTANT DEADLINES

- October 10, 2017 – Last day to register for November Election
 - A person may register at any Secretary of State Branch Office, at the Clerk's Office, or by mail. **IMPORTANT:** If you register by mail, you **MUST** vote in person for your first Election. This does not apply to persons 60 years of age or older. [Voter Registration Form](#)
- November 4, 2017 2pm – Last day to request an AV ballot by mail
- November 6, 2017 4pm – Last day to vote AV at the Clerk's office

ABSENT VOTER INFORMATION (AV)

All voters who receive an AV ballot in person at the Clerk's Office must present a photo ID or sign an affidavit. If the voter signs the affidavit, his/her AV ballot must be prepared as a challenged ballot. [Absent Voter Ballot Application](#)

You are eligible for an absentee ballot if you meet any of the following criteria:

- Are 60 years of age or older
- Are physically unable to attend the polls without assistance of another
- Are appointed as a precinct worker in a precinct other than your own
- Expect to be absent from the community in which you are registered on election day
- Cannot attend the polls because of the tenets of your religion
- Cannot attend the polls because you are confined to jail awaiting arraignment or trial

Completed ballots must be received by the close of polls and can be mailed, hand delivered to the Clerk's Office or placed in the green City drop box located in the parking lot behind the Cinema.

PERMANENT ABSENT VOTER APPLICATION LIST

The City of Charlevoix maintains a Permanent Absent Voter Application List for registered voters who elect to automatically receive an application for an Absent Voter Ballot prior to each election. If you would like to be placed on this mailing list contact the Clerk's Office.
